

SOUTHEASTERN INTERFRATERNITY CONFERENCE RESOLUTION ON FRATERNITY EXPANSION

Whereas the Interfraternity Councils and similar such bodies are the governing bodies of the fraternity systems of their respective institutions,

Whereas an Interfraternity Council's expansion policy is structured so as to provide for a fair and equal opportunity for expansion of all national and international fraternities,

Whereas an Interfraternity Council's expansion policy is structured so that it provides for proper expansion planning that is conducive to and strengthens an Interfraternity Council's fraternity system,

Whereas an Interfraternity Council has the responsibility to insure the stability and success of their fraternity systems, has the inherent right to establish a fair and reasonable expansion policy for their fraternity system,

Whereas expansion efforts should be a cooperative effort of both the fraternity wishing to expand and the Interfraternity Council of the host institution at which expansion is desired.

Therefore be it resolved that the Southeastern Interfraternity Conference supports the rights of Interfraternity Councils to establish legitimate expansion policies, that national and international fraternities should respect the autonomy of Interfraternity Councils and their host institutions, and that national and international fraternities should respect and comply with the expansion policies set forth by Interfraternity Councils.
